



Application for Veteran's Licence Plate Eligibility Certification

Important:

- The applicant's name must appear on the vehicle's registration certificate issued by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ).
- Only licence plates for passenger vehicles, motor homes of 3,000 kg or less, motorcycles, mopeds or scooters may be replaced with a veteran's licence plate. See the list of ineligible vehicles in the "General Information" section.

Veteran's licence plate eligibility criteria (please check the applicable box)

- ☐ I served in WWII, in Korea during the Korean War, or in Vietnam during the Vietnam War as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces, **or** an allied force, **or** the United States Armed Forces, **or** the Merchant Marine **or** Ferry Command.
- ☐ I served or I am serving in the Canadian Armed Forces, including the Reserve Force (paid duty).
- ☐ I served in NATO operations or in a United Nations peacekeeping mission as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces **or** an allied force, **or** the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), another Canadian police force or as a federal or provincial correctional services officer.
- ☐ I served or am serving as a member of the RCMP.

You must enclose a photocopy of the proof of service corresponding to your situation. The document must be in either English or French; otherwise, you must also provide a certified translation.

- ☐ **Retired member:** Both sides of your Certificate of Service or discharge certificate from the Canadian Armed Forces (or equivalent document from the Merchant Marine, allied force, etc.)
- ☐ **Serving member:** Military certificate confirming the type of service (regular force or the Reserve Force)
- ☐ **Police or correctional services officer:** Letter from your police or correctional service confirming your involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations peacekeeping mission. In the case of the RCMP, a letter confirming your service.

- Under the *Highway Safety Code*, the personal information entered on this form is used for the purpose of determining the applicant's eligibility for a veteran's licence plate and an updated vehicle registration certificate.

Protection of Personal Information

The SAAQ only collects personal information that is necessary for it to exercise its powers and apply the laws it administers. All personal information gathered by authorized personnel is handled confidentially. This information may be shared with its licensing agents and certain government departments or agencies, including those located outside Québec, in accordance with the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*. It may also be used for statistical, survey, study, audit or investigative purposes. Failure to provide this information can result in a refusal of service. You may consult, correct or obtain a copy of any personal information concerning you.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Ineligible vehicles for a veteran's licence plate

- Commercial vehicles and special use vehicles (F licence plates)
- Trailers, camping trailers and tent trailers (R licence plates)
- Buses and minibuses (A licence plates)
- Off-road vehicles (V licence plates)
- All-terrain vehicles (V licence plates)
- Amateur radio operator vehicles (VA2 or VE2 licence plates)
- Vehicles with restricted-area use, such as tractors and other farm vehicles (C licence plates)
- Heavy vehicles (L licence plates)
- Passenger vehicles used in a locality not linked to the Québec highway system, or with limited area of operation (C licence plates)
- Vehicles with a dealer plate (X licence plates)

Application for veteran's licence plate eligibility certification

- The applicant must complete the application form and enclose a photocopy of the proof of service mentioned in the section entitled “Enclosed proof of service.” There is a \$15 administrative fee which can be paid by enclosing a cheque made payable to the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command. Payment may also be made by credit card by calling Québec Command at 1-877-401-7111, ext. 225. The completed and signed application form must be sent to the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command at the address given below.
- On receipt of the application, the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command will validate the applicant’s eligibility. If the applicant is eligible for a veteran’s licence plate, the application form bearing the Québec Command seal will be sent to the SAAQ. A copy of this form and the proof of service will be kept by the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command. There is no need to go to an SAAQ service outlet, either to submit your application or to obtain your veteran’s plate.

Veteran's licence plate delivery

- Once the SAAQ has received the application form bearing the seal of the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command, it will check the applicant's record and issue an updated vehicle registration certificate and veteran's licence plate, unless the applicant's record warrants otherwise. In that case, the SAAQ may contact the applicant.
- The plate and the vehicle registration certificate will be sent **by mail**, to the applicant's address on file at the SAAQ.

The licence plate must be affixed to the veteran's vehicle upon receipt.

The plate cannot be transferred even if the vehicle in question is donated.
