| You are a Class 1 candidate with a valid Class 5 driver’s licence and a Class 1 learner’s licence that was valid on December 14, 2025. | Not required if you obtain your Class 1 driver’s licence no later than June 15, 2027. | The knowledge test is not required. You must pass the road tests no later than June 15, 2027. | You have until June 15, 2027 to obtain your Class 1 driver’s licence if you wish to follow the procedure in place at the time you obtained your Class 1 learner’s licence. | You can apply for the F and M endorsements. Training is not mandatory in your case. You must pass the knowledge and road tests. Note that if you already passed the F endorsement knowledge test when applying for another licence class, you will only have to pass the F endorsement road test. |
| You are a Class 1 candidate with a valid Class 5 probationary licence and a Class 1 learner’s licence that was valid on December 14, 2025. | Not required if you obtain your Class 1 driver’s licence no later than March 15, 2029. | The knowledge test is not required. You must pass the road tests no later than March 15, 2029. | You have until March 15, 2029 to obtain your Class 1 driver’s licence if you wish to follow the procedure in place at the time you obtained your Class 1 learner’s licence. | You can apply for the F and M endorsements. Training is not mandatory in your case. You must pass the knowledge and road tests. Note that if you already passed the F endorsement knowledge test when applying for another licence class, you will only have to pass the F endorsement road test. |

Note that if your Class 1 learner’s licence expired and was not renewed before December 15, 2025, you will have to take a training course.
