- 1** Try to obtain a copy of the police report.
- 2** Note the names and addresses of the other drivers involved as well as witnesses.
- 3** Write down all the details of the accident and take photographs of the scene and damage to the vehicles.

Before signing a document or accepting any money following a traffic accident:

- » contact the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec and your private insurer, regardless of where you are in the world.
