Subject: Consent by the holder of a driver's licence from a jurisdiction that does not have a licence exchange agreement with Québec

The SAAQ wishes to remind you of circumstances that could apply after having taken your road test, so that you can continue to safely drive on Québec roads.

If you pass the road test:

- You will be issued a regular **driver's licence** if the SAAQ recognizes **24 or more months** of driving experience.
- You will be issued a **probationary licence** if the SAAQ recognizes **less than 24 months** of driving experience.

If you fail the road test:

- You will no longer be authorized to drive with your foreign driver's licence. If you drive without a valid Québec licence:
 - you will be liable to a fine of between \$300 and \$600;
 - the vehicle you were driving may be seized and impounded for 30 days at the owner's expense.
- You will be issued a **Class 5 learner's licence**, which comes with the following conditions:
 - You must be accompanied while driving by someone who has held a valid Québec Class 5 driver's licence for at least two years.
 - You must not drive between midnight and 5 a.m.
 - You must abide by the zero-alcohol rule.
 - You must always have fewer than 4 demerit points on your driving record.

Paying your road test and driver's licence fees

When you report to your road test appointment, you need to be able to pay all applicable fees for your test and your driver's licence (service receipt). If you do not have any offences on record, these fees can amount to \$120.

Please note that once you begin your road test, you are required to pay the road test fee. You will be issued the appropriate driver's licence, and you will be charged the applicable licence fees.
