RULES

- The youngest player plays first.
- In a clockwise direction, take turns rolling a die.
- Did you land on a square with a picture? You must read a safety rule out loud.
- The first player to land directly on square 31 wins.
- If you roll a higher number, you must go back according to the extra number of squares you rolled.

SAFETY RULES

1. Wear light-coloured clothing with reflective strips.
2. Wear short clothing.
3. Put on make-up instead of wearing a mask.
4. Use a flashlight.
5. Tell your parents where you're going and when you'll be back.
6. Trick-or-treat in a group or with an adult, and always wait outside each house.
7. Trick-or-treat on one side of the street at a time, and only cross when you need to.
8. Cross the street at intersections and pay attention to traffic lights and signals.
9. Don't go near or get into a vehicle without permission from your parents.
10. With your parents, check the candy you get to make sure it's safe to eat.
