

# Move-Over Law

On highways, rural roads and city streets, the Move-Over Law ensures the safety of workers on the side of the road, including:

- police officers,
- firefighters,
- ambulance drivers and paramedics,
- carrier enforcement officers,
- road surveillance officers,
- wildlife protection officers,
- tow truck drivers.



Obey the law and create a buffer lane when a worker's vehicle is stopped and its flashing or rotating lights or yellow arrow light signals are activated.

## Penalties for not obeying the Move-Over Law

- a \$200 to \$300 fine, plus additional fees,
- 4 demerit points.



# How to obey the Move-Over Law

- Slow down and stop if necessary.
- Put as much distance as possible between you and the stopped vehicle.



## If you can do so safely:
