During road work, the layout of the road can vary from one moment to the next: traffic obstructions, detours, narrow lanes, etc.

**Stay alert!**

## HOW?

**Watch out for flagpersons and other road workers, because:**

- they often work during the day, and sometimes at night;
- they may be hidden by machines, material or structures;
- they are not always protected by cones, delineator posts or cement-block barriers.

**Respect the orange road work signs and the posted speed limit.**

**Before heading out:**

- check Québec 511 to find out about traffic obstructions, closures and detours along your route;
- plan your routes and give yourself more time for your trips.

**Always be patient and courteous to other drivers.**

## PENALTIES

**Important: Note that fines are doubled for speeding in road work zones!**

**Travelling at 90 km/h in a road work zone where the posted speed limit on an orange sign is 70 km/h:**

- \$140, plus additional costs;
- one demerit point.

**Failing to obey the orders of a flagperson:**

- \$300 to \$600, plus additional costs;
- four demerit points.
