

AN ESSENTIAL SAFETY CAMPAIGN

From January 29 to February 9, 2018, the Bus Carriers Federation will hold a school bus safety campaign in collaboration with many partners, including the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ). The theme *Did you see me?* speaks directly to school children, who must make sure they are seen by the bus driver whenever they go near or get off a school bus. Children must also be seen by other road users, whether they are going to the bus stop or crossing in front of the bus.
