Before buying or leasing
a used motor vehicle,
obtain its ownership history.



Québec 

Before buying or leasing a used motor vehicle, obtain its ownership history to find out:

- if it has been rebuilt;
- if it has undergone a mechanical inspection;
- how many people have owned it;
- how it has been used in the past, e.g. if it was used as a taxi before October 10, 2020.

To obtain the vehicle's ownership history, you can:

- use the online service available via [SAAQclic](#);
- go to one of our service outlets.

Further verification recommended

You should also consult the [Register of personal and movable real rights](#) (RDPRM—in French only) to make sure the vehicle is free of debt. If you buy a vehicle that has not been paid for in full, it can be seized by the creditor.

1. File opened on

Date the vehicle was first registered in Québec.

2. GVWR (gross vehicle weight rating)

The GVWR is used to determine if a vehicle is considered a heavy vehicle within the meaning of the *Act respecting owners, operators and drivers of a heavy vehicle*. This information is required if the vehicle weighs 4,500 kg or more.

3. Date withdrawn

Date on which the vehicle was withdrawn from Québec registration; the reason (vehicle discarded, severely damaged, licensed outside Québec, etc.) is shown under "Vehicle Status."

4. Number of cylinders/cylinder capacity

Information provided to identify large-cylinder capacity vehicles (4 litres or more) that are subject to an additional registration fee.

5. Provenance

Jurisdiction outside Québec in which the vehicle was last registered, or where the vehicle was acquired from a dealership operating outside Québec.

6. Out of province

Province, state or country to which the vehicle has been sent following its sale to a resident of a jurisdiction outside Québec, or the jurisdiction where the owner moved after cancellation of Québec registration.

7. Ownership history

An entry is created for every ownership transfer (owner, long-term lessee or dealer). Dealership entries are not required, as dealerships are exempt from vehicle registration requirements.

8. Name of owner or long-term lessee

Under the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*, the SAAQ is not allowed to disclose the name of an individual (natural person). Only the names of legal persons (business firms or companies) may be shown.

9. Declared odometer reading

Reading available only for vehicles registered from September 10, 2001, the date on which the SAAQ began recording this information. If the information is unavailable, the reason for the absence will be stated in the following field.

10. Date ceded

Date ownership transfer took place due to the vehicle being sold or given as a gift, bankruptcy, or the end of a long-term lease.

11. Periods of use of the vehicle

The record of entry of more than one period for the same type of use indicates that the vehicle was not licensed for road use at some point. The reason and length of time the vehicle was not used on the road is not detailed in the record kept by the SAAQ, but usually corresponds to seasonal storage.
