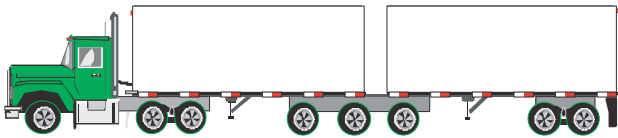
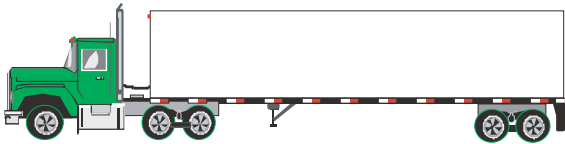


DRIVER’S LICENCE CLASSES

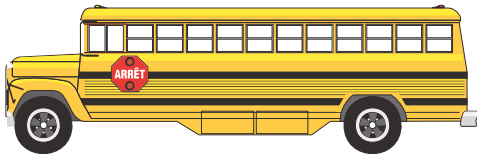
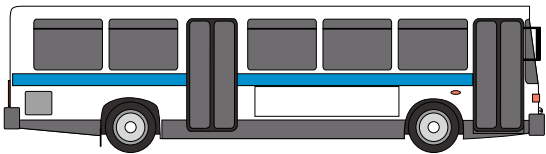
1 A combination of road vehicles made up of:

- a double-axle road tractor with a net mass of 4,500 kg or more hauling one or more trailers or semi-trailers
- a road tractor with three axles or more hauling one or more trailers or semi-trailers
- a truck covered by Class 3 hauling a trailer or semi-trailer whose net mass is 4,500 kg or more and which is only used to transport the machinery, implements or fixtures with which it is permanently equipped
- a truck covered by Class 3 hauling any other trailer or semi-trailer with a net mass of 2,000 kg or more



Classes covered: 2, 3, 4A, 4B, 5, 6D and 8

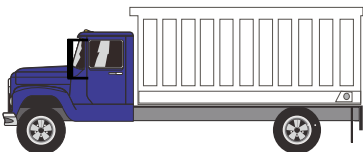
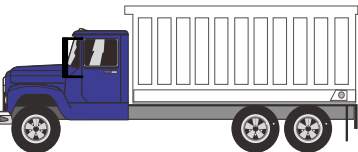
2 Buses with a seating capacity of more than 24 passengers



Classes covered: 3, 4A, 4B, 5, 6D and 8

3 Straight-body trucks with:

- three or more axles
- OR
- two axles and a net mass of 4,500 kg or over



Classes covered: 4A, 4B, 5, 6D and 8

Truck tractors with 2 axles and a net mass of 4,500 kg or more, or truck tractors with 3 axles or more, provided they are not hitched to a trailer or semi-trailer

A Class 3 licence also authorizes its holder to drive road vehicles covered by this class hauling a trailer or semi-trailer:

- with a net mass of less than 2,000 kg
- or
- with a net mass of at least 2,000 kg but less than 4,500 kg and which is only used to transport the machinery, implements or fixtures with which it is permanently equipped.

Endorsements

- F to drive a heavy vehicle equipped with an air brake system
- M to drive a heavy vehicle equipped with manual (standard) transmission
- T to drive a road train, that is, a double road train more than 25 metres long that requires a special road train operating permit

4A Emergency vehicles (i.e. ambulances, police vehicles or fire trucks)



Classes covered: 4A, 4B, 5, 6D and 8

4B Minibuses or buses with a seating capacity of 24 passengers or less



Classes covered: 5, 6D and 8

5 Taxis or vehicles comparable to a taxi

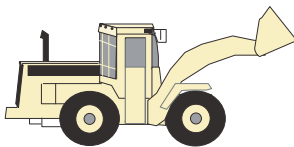
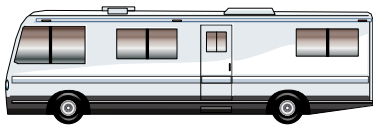


Classes covered: 6D and 8

- Passenger vehicles (automobiles or mini-vans) or double-axle trucks with a net mass of less than 4,500 kg
- Motor homes
- Tool vehicles: road vehicles—other than a vehicle mounted on a truck chassis—manufactured to perform work, and the work station of which is an integral part of the driver's cab
- Service vehicles: vehicles equipped to refuel, repair or tow road vehicles



Classes covered: 6D and 8

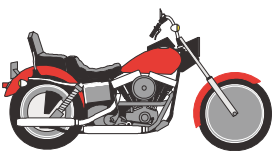


For the purposes of this definition, a truck chassis is a frame equipped with all the mechanical components required on a road vehicle designed for the transportation of passengers, goods or equipment.



Any vehicle covered by this class hauling a trailer or, in the case of a motor home, another vehicle

6A All motorcycles



Classes covered: 6B, 6C, 6D, 6E and 8

6B Motorcycles with an engine displacement of 400 cc or less



Classes covered: 6C, 6D, 6E and 8

6C Motorcycles with an engine displacement of 125 cc or less



Classes covered: 6D, 6E and 8

6D Mopeds and scooters



6E Three-wheeled motorcycles not equipped with a sidecar



8 Farm tractors



Classes	Required Medical Assessment
1, 2, 3, 4A and 4B	Upon application for the class and when the holder turns 45, 55, 60 and 65, and every two years thereafter
5, 6A, 6B, 6C, 6D and 8	When the holder turns 75 and 80, and every two years thereafter
