PREPARING FOR THE KNOWLEDGE AND ROAD TESTS

Have you recently settled in Québec?

If you want to exchange your current licence for a Québec licence, you may be required to pass a knowledge or road test. Take the time to learn about road safety rules and carefully prepare for your tests:

IMPORTANT

If your driver's licence was issued in a country with which Québec does not have a reciprocity agreement

It may be possible for you to exchange your licence, provided you have held it for at least one year. However, you must first pass the knowledge and road tests.

If you fail the road test:

- You will no longer be authorized to drive with your foreign driver's licence.
- You will be issued a learner's licence.

The day of the road test

Have someone come with you who can drive your vehicle if need be.
