



Prospective Three-Wheeled Motorcycle Driver (Class 6E)

If you are a new driver of a three-wheeled motorcycle, to operate this type of vehicle in Québec you must:

- hold a valid Class 6A driver's licence or probationary licence (all types of motorcycles), 6B or 6C;

or

- hold a valid Class 5 (passenger vehicle) **and** Class 6E driver's licence.



Prospective **Three**-Wheeled Motorcycle Driver (Class 6E)

Conditions for obtaining a Class 6E licence

You must meet the following criteria:

- hold a valid Class 5 driver's licence (passenger vehicle) **and**;
 - pass one of the following courses, offered by motorcycle driving schools recognized by the Association québécoise du transport (AQTr):
 - the *Road Safety Education Program – Operating a Three-Wheeled Motorcycle* course;
- or**
- the motorcycle driving course.

To retain the privilege of driving a three-wheeled motorcycle, you must hold a valid Class 5 driver's licence.

One-Day Course

The *Road Safety Education Program – Operating a Three-Wheeled Motorcycle* driving course lasts 7 hours.

The goals of the program are:

- to promote safe, cooperative and responsible driving;
- to prepare to operate a three-wheeled motorcycle;
- to educate about the related risks on the road network.
