



Québec Application for Veteran's Licence Plate Eligibility Certification

- Important:**
- This application covers only one vehicle.
 - The applicant's name must appear on the vehicle's registration certificate issued by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ).
 - Only licence plates of passenger vehicles, motor homes of 3,000 kg or less, or motorcycles may be replaced with the veteran's licence plate.

Eligibility Criteria for Veteran's Licence Plate (please check applicable box)

I served in WWII, in Korea during the Korean War, or in Vietnam during the Vietnam War:
 - as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces, **or**
 - as a member of an Allied force, **or**
 - as a member of the United States Armed Forces, **or**
 - as a member of the Merchant Marine **or** Ferry Command.

I served or I am serving in the Canadian Armed Forces, including the Reserve Force (paid duty).

I served in NATO operations or in a United Nations peacekeeping mission:
 - as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces
 - as a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) **or** another Canadian police force or as a correctional services officer (federal or provincial), **or**
 - as a member of an Allied force.

I served or I am serving as a member of the RCMP.

Proof of Service to be Included (please check applicable box)

You must include a photocopy of the proof of service corresponding to your situation. The document must be in either English or French; a certified translation must accompany a document in any other language.

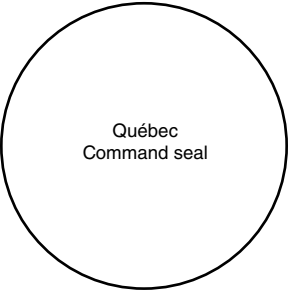
Retired Personnel: Canadian Armed Forces discharge certificate/certificate of service – both sides (and equivalent for Merchant Marine, Allied forces, etc.).

Serving Personnel: A military certificate confirming the type of service (regular force or reserve force) and also confirming (if applicable):
 - receipt of the Canadian Forces Decoration (CD), **or**
 - involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations peacekeeping mission.

Police and Correctional Services Personnel: Letter from your police force or correctional service confirming your involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations peacekeeping mission. In the case of the RCMP, a letter confirming service.

Personal information entered on this form is gathered under the *Highway Safety Code* for the purpose of determining an applicant's eligibility for a veteran's licence plate and an updated vehicle registration certificate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Application for Veteran's Licence Plate Eligibility Certification

- The applicant must submit the completed and signed application form, along with a photocopy of the proof of service that applies to his/her situation (see the section entitled «Proof of Service to be Included») to the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command at the address given below. A cheque or money order for \$15 made payable to the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command to cover administrative costs is also required.
- On receipt of the application, The Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command will validate the applicant's eligibility. If the applicant is eligible for a veteran's licence plate, the application form bearing the Québec Command seal will be sent to the SAAQ. A copy of this form and of the proof of service will be kept by the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command. There is no need to go to an SAAQ office, either to submit your application or to obtain your veteran's plate.

Veteran's Licence Plate Delivery

- Once the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command has certified a veteran's eligibility, the SAAQ will check the applicant's record and issue an updated vehicle registration certificate and veteran's licence plate, unless the applicant's record warrants otherwise. In that case, the SAAQ may contact the applicant.
- The plate and the vehicle registration certificate will be sent free of charge, **by mail**, to the applicant's address that appears in the SAAQ files.

The licence plate must be affixed to the veteran's vehicle at once.

The plate cannot be transferred even if the vehicle in question is donated.
