

IMPORTANT:

This form is for any person whose driver's licence or the right to obtain one has been suspended for 30, 60 or 90 days for any of the reasons listed below.

A favourable decision by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) could result in:

- the suspension of the licence or the right to obtain one being lifted;
- the vehicle being released from seizure and impoundment, if applicable.

If the reason(s) for the suspension (see the statement of suspension or the statement of seizure) involved street racing or car surfing (reasons 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34), distracted driving (reason 14) or the illegal operation of a taxi service (reason 22), a motion must be filed before the Court of Québec, using the *Application to Lift Suspension of a Driver's Licence or the Right to Obtain One* form, available from the Ministère de la Justice.

To be accepted, your application for review must include all the required documents. The above-mentioned brochure provides a list of the documents you must file with your application.

The penalties and the conditions for obtaining a new licence that apply under the *Highway Safety Code* are separate from those that apply under the *Criminal Code*. Even if you are not charged with or not convicted of a criminal offence, the licence suspension imposed under the *Highway Safety Code* will remain in effect and you will still have to undergo an assessment. The fact that you do not face criminal charges, or have not been found guilty of any criminal charges brought against you, therefore does not constitute grounds for review.

If a driver provides sufficient evidence that his or her blood alcohol concentration was not equal to or in excess of 160 mg of alcohol per 100 ml of blood at the time of the offence, but rather only equal to or in excess of 80 mg per 100 ml of blood, the SAAQ may decide to lift the vehicle seizure and impoundment. In such a case, however, the suspension of the licence or the right to obtain one remains in effect.
