During road work, the layout of the road can vary from one moment to the next: traffic obstructions, detours, narrow lanes, etc.

**Stay alert!**

## HOW?

- Pay attention to flagpersons and other road workers.
  - They often work during the day, and sometimes at night.
  - They may be hidden by machines, material or structures.
  - They are not always protected by cones, delineator posts or cement-block barriers.
- Respect the orange road work signs and the posted speed limit
  - Fines are doubled for speeding in road work zones!

## PENALTIES

**Travelling at 90 km/h in a road work zone where the posted speed limit on an orange sign is 70 km/h**

- \$110, plus costs;
- 1 demerit point.

**Failing to obey the orders of a flagperson**

- \$200 to \$400, plus costs;
- 4 demerit points.
