SAFETY RATING – ADDITION OF THE NOTATION “UNAUDITED”

As of July 3, 2015, the notation “unaudited” will automatically accompany the safety rating of all heavy vehicle owners and operators (HVOOs) that are currently assigned a “Satisfactory” safety rating.

This notation will also be entered in the record of new HVOOs as soon as they register in the register of owners and operators of heavy vehicles of the Commission des transports du Québec (CTQ). The purpose of this addition is to harmonize Québec’s standards with those of other Canadian jurisdictions.

The CTQ assigns a safety rating to all persons registered in the Commission’s register. This rating refers to that person’s conduct with regard to road safety and protection of the road network.

Thus, the safety ratings that apply in Québec will be worded as follows:

- Satisfactory – unaudited OR Satisfactory
- Conditional
- Unsatisfactory

WITHDRAWAL OF THE NOTATION “UNAUDITED”

The notation “unaudited” is withdrawn as soon as an HVOO passes a full facility audit carried out by Contrôle routier Québec in accordance with the standards set forth in the *Conduct Review Policy for HVOOs*. However, no facility audit can be carried out at the request of an HVOO.
